ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13

**AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE RATE OF TAX FOR 2024/2025
TAX YEAR AND LEVYING TAXES UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL
PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF HOLLADAY, UTAH.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Holladay must adopt the certified tax rate in conjunction with the adoption of the fiscal budget on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the requisite public notices and hearings have been published and conducted for the adoption of a certified tax rate that exceeds the rate established by the Salt Lake County Auditor including all required notices and hearings as set forth in *Utah Code Ann.* §§59-2-919-923; and

WHEREAS, the certified tax rate must be adopted on or before the 30th day of August for this year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Holladay, Utah as follows:

Section 1. Tax Rate and Levy.

A. For the purpose of defraying the necessary and proper expenses of the City of Holladay and for maintaining the government thereof, and consistent with the final adoption of a certified tax rate after consideration of an increased rate thought the Truth in Taxation process, it is hereby determined that the rate of the general property tax to be levied against all real and personal property within the City of Holladay made taxable by law for the Fiscal Year 2024/2025, is hereby, and for purposes of the operating budget of the City until the final budget is approved, set at **0.001436** for the General Fund and General Purposes which rate does exceed the certified rate determined by the Salt Lake County Auditor's Office.

B. There is hereby levied upon all real and personal property within the City of Holladay made taxable by law in the Fiscal Year 2024/2025, for the fiscal year of the City of Holladay ending June 30, 2025, the tax rate set forth above, on the taxable value of said property, to provide revenue for the City of Holladay General Fund, Capital Projects Fund and for general City purposes.

C. As required by law, the rate hereinabove determined and levied, along with all statements and information required by law, shall be reported to the Salt Lake County Auditor, State of Utah, and the Utah State Tax Commission.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication or posting, or twenty days after passage, whichever occurs first, as required by law, and shall be deposited and recorded in the office of the City Recorder.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-14

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF HOLLADAY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2025.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Holladay, as required by law, submitted to the City Council of the City of Holladay a tentative budget including all supporting schedules and data (herein the “*Tentative Budget*”) on May 2, 2024 for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Tentative Budget was approved by the City Council on May 2, 2024, subject to the City proceeding with a Truth in Taxation hearing to consider public input on the proposed mill levy rate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the required notice for the Truth in Taxation hearing and the resulting budget was given by publication as required by law in advance of the Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, all interested persons participating in the public hearing were given an opportunity to be heard, for or against, the estimate of revenues and expenditures or any item thereof in the Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the City Council, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, must adopt a final budget and set the property tax levy before the 30th day of August of as a result in the proposed increase in the certified tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Holladay to adopt a final budget as proposed, with the increase in mill levy rate for the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Holladay, Utah as follows:

Section 1. Budget Adoption.

A. The budgeted amounts shown in *Exhibit A*, City of Holladay 2024/2025 Budget, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City of Holladay, Utah for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025, and are hereby adopted as the Budget of the City of Holladay, Utah for the Fiscal Year 2024-25, subject to any revisions that may be adopted through the Truth in Taxation process, as required by state law and as directed by the City Council.

B. Pursuant to law, a copy of the Budget shall be certified by the City Manager as the “Budget Officer” and shall be filed with the State Auditor within 30 days after adoption of the Budget.

C. Pursuant to law, a certified copy of the Budget shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours.

Section 2. Further Action.

A. In addition to the foregoing, the City Manager is hereby directed to implement any other necessary actions pertinent to the adoption of the Budget.

B. Budget surpluses in excess of the 25% maximum fund balance in the General Fund allowed by State law will be distributed to the Capital Projects Fund.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication or posting, or twenty days after passage, whichever occurs first, as required by law, and shall be deposited and recorded in the office of the City Recorder.
